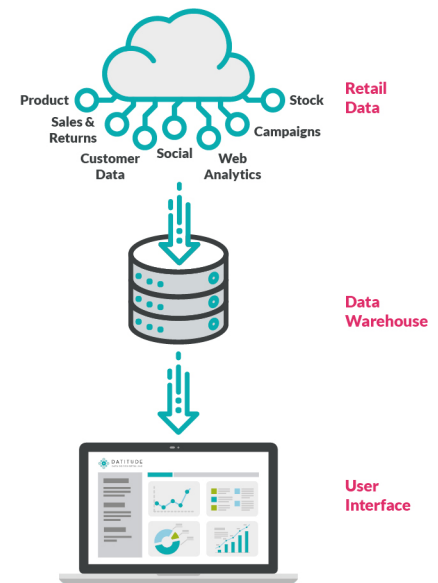

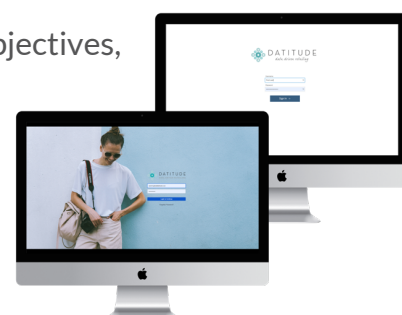

- championing quality and innovation to support our business objectives, including great user experience.

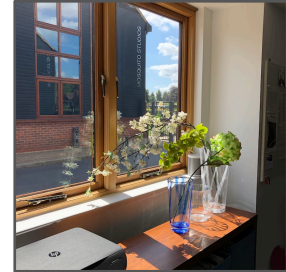

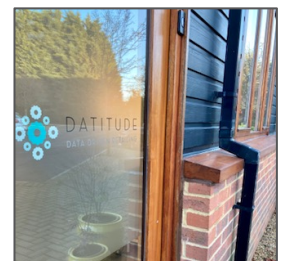
